

## Fire, Water, Earth & Air

Selected photographs from the 2006 and 2008 Institute for Conservation Biology photocompetitions will be Exhibited at the Wollongong City Gallery from the 15th August to the 3 November 2009.

The full title of the Exhibition "Fire, Water, Earth and Air - the elements of conservation", sums up the main research areas within the ICB, namely Fire Ecology, Marine Biology, Terrestrial Biology and Avian Biology.
